Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has increased from 5.9% (March 2015) to 6.5% (March 2016).
- In March 2016, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 5.6% compared to last year and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 15.9%.
- In March 2016, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 11.33 weeks, compared to last year's level of 11.47 weeks
