

## Illinois Department of Employment Security Legislative District Dashboard

## Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from 5.0% (March 2017) to 4.6% (March 2018).
  In March 2018, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 9.9% compared to last year,
- and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 14.2%.
- In March 2018, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 11.47 weeks, compared to last year's level of 11.37 weeks.
