Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from its peak of 12.2% (January 2010) to 8.3% (November 2013) not seasonally adjusted.
- In December 2013, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 12.3% compared to last year, and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 21.8%.
- In December 2013, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois was 11.35 weeks, compared to last year's level of 10.78 weeks.

Statewide

The total number of claimants certified for collecting regular UI benefits is 153,733.

These claimants viewed 51,282 job orders and activated 9,920 job applications.

The total number of claimants certified for extended benefits is 78,438.

The information that follows only includes claimants certified for state (non-Federal) regular UI benefits.


