

Illinois Department of Employment Security Legislative District Dashboard



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Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from 6.1% (December 2015) to 5.7% (December 2016)
- In December 2016, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 11.9% compared to last year and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 8%.
- In December 2016, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 10.83 weeks, compared to last year's level of 10.78 weeks
 The increase in average duration reflects the dramatic drop in new certifications.

The total number of claimants certified for collecting regular UI benefits is 117,490.

These claimants viewed 207,221 job orders and activated 31,495 job applications.
