Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from 4.9% (December 2017) to 4.3% (December 2018)
- In December 2018, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 10% compared to last year
 and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 12.7%.
- In December 2018, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 10.36 weeks, compared to last year's level of 10.87 weeks

The total number of claimants certified for collecting regular UI benefits is 100,406.

These claimants viewed 144,804 job orders and activated 21,074 job applications.
