Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from 4.3% (December 2018) to 3.7% (December 2019).
- In December 2019, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois decreased by 2.1% compared to last year, and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits declined by 9.6%.

 In December 2019, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 10.28 weeks, compared to last year's level of 10.36 weeks.

The total number of claimants certified for collecting regular UI benefits is 100,043.

These claimants viewed 153,151 job orders and activated 24,071 job applications.
