

## Illinois Department of Employment Security Legislative District Dashboard

## Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from 5.9% (June 2016) to 4.7% (June 2017).
- In June 2017, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 11.9% compared to last year,
- and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 14.7%.
- In June 2017, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 12.33 weeks, compared to last year's level of 12.45 weeks.

The total number of claimants certified for collecting regular UI benefits is 100,303.
