Statewide:

- The Illinois unemployment rate has declined from 4.9% (June 2017) to 4.3% (June 2018)
- In June 2018, the total number of claimants for regular unemployment insurance benefits in Illinois declined by 13.2% compared to last year
 and new certifications for regular unemployment insurance benefits dropped by 14.7%.
- In June 2018, the average duration of claimants for regular benefits in Illinois is 12.24 weeks, compared to last year's level of 12.34 weeks

The total number of claimants certified for collecting regular UI benefits is 89,316.

These claimants viewed 167,996 job orders and activated 24,297 job applications.
