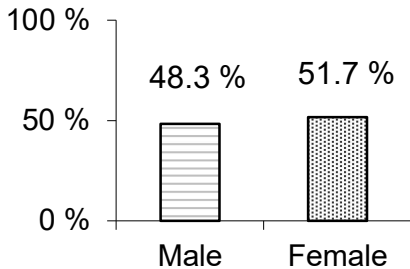

Population by Sex and Race & Ethnicity

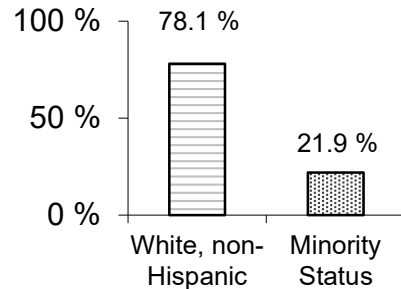

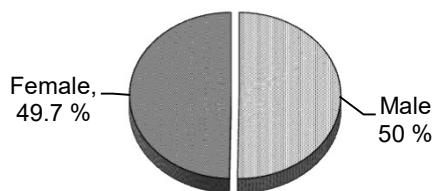

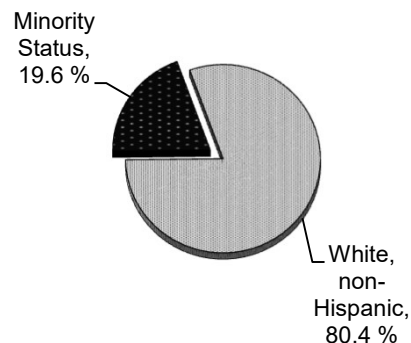
